## **ADVOCACY STRIDES**

The LHEC's continued partnership with Ostroff Associates, an Albany-based government relations firm, has permitted LHEC to quickly change the focus of advocacy from the Legislature to the Governor's office as executive orders became a primary governance mechanism in Albany. Ostroff's relationships with key staff provide opportunities to share LHEC priorities and give input on emerging issues. Inroads made on behalf of our region this year include:

- Timely monitoring of legislation and executive orders regarding COVID-19, education aid, school elections and budget votes.
- Ongoing discussions regarding school aid and advocacy at the state and federal level for public education funding.
- Tracking the path of education bills awaiting the Governor's signature.
- Working with districts on successful individual aid forgiveness bills while advocating for broad legislation.
- Support for Special Act Districts on permitting reserve funds and additional financial flexibility measures.
- Assistance to individual districts in navigating the administrative and legislative processes of Albany.
