ADVOCACY STRIDES

The LHEC's continued partnership with Ostroff Associates, an Albany-based government relations firm, has permitted the LHEC to advocate more effectively with the NYS Legislature, Governor's office and the NYS Department of Education. Ostroff's relationships with key staff provide opportunities to share LHEC priorities and give input on emerging issues. In the past year, advocacy efforts on behalf of our region have included:

- Meeting on a regular basis with legislators and key staff to share the priorities of the LHEC.
- Ongoing discussions regarding school aid and advocacy at the state and federal level for public education funding.
- Tracking the path of education bills awaiting the Governor's signature.
- Focusing support for legislation that targets current issues affecting individual districts and the region.
- Support for Special Act Districts on fiscal and tuition legislation and implementation.
- Assisting individual districts with navigating the administrative and legislative processes of Albany.
